CONFESSION OF SIN Rev. Sandra Nunnally

PASTOR: Let us confess our sins.

CONFESSION Unison

Most merciful God, we confess that we are in bondage to sin and cannot free ourselves. We have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. For the sake of Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in your will and follow in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

PASTOR: In the mercy of almighty God, Jesus Christ was given to die for us, and for his sake God forgives us all our sins. We are the children of God and bestows on us the Holy Spirit.

PEOPLE: Amen.

PASTOR: God be with you.

PEOPLE: And also with you.

PASTOR: Lift up your hearts.

PEOPLE: We lift them to God.

PASTOR: Let us give thanks to God Most High.

PEOPLE: It is right to give God thanks and praise.

PASTOR: It is indeed right and salutary that we should at all times and in all places offer thanks and praise to you, O God, through Christ our Lord; who on this day overcame death and the grave, and by his glorious resurrection opened to us the way of everlasting life. And so with the Church on earth and the hosts of heaven, we praise your name and join their unending hymn:

ALL: Holy, holy God of love and majesty, the whole universe speaks of your glory, O God Most High.

PASTOR: In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: "Take and eat; this is my body given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of me."
